High Holiday Seating Options

All of our members are invited and welcome to worship in our sanctuary for every service and occasion. When we all come together during the high holidays, these services become especially meaningful. Our sanctuary generously accommodates Temple Beth Rishon's large and growing congregation, and there is plentiful seating for all. We offer a general open seating policy for all ticket holders, but also make available permanent reserved seating and single-year reserved seating for use during the High Holidays to accommodate the needs of all of our congregants.

Long-Term Seating

When the members of Temple Beth Rishon built our current sanctuary in 2002, they began a tradition common to many synagogue communities, making available for purchase seats located in the sanctuary. The proceeds from the sale of these seats go toward the benefit of the temple community in areas such as education, programming, and upkeep of the building and grounds.

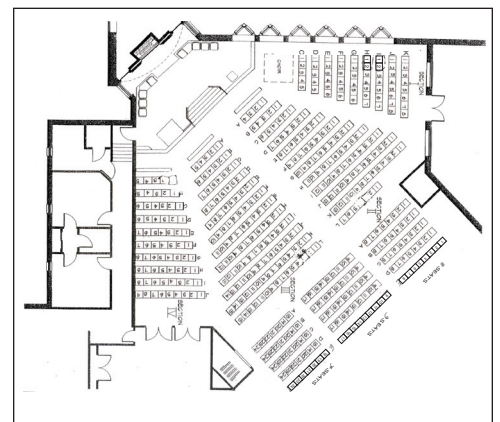
Once purchased, the seats remain available for use by the "owners" for as long as they are a member in good standing of the Temple. These seats are reserved for the purchasers during High Holiday services only. This includes all Rosh Hashanah services, Kol Nidre and Yom Kippur services with the exception of the afternoon and evening Yom Kippur services which offer open seating. The seats are open to all congregants during the rest of the year.

Long-term seats are located in the main sanctuary and Section E. (Please see the seating chart for reference.) Seats may

become available in different groupings and locations of the sanctuary, and may change as our membership evolves. Availability is on a first come first served basis. Please see the seating chart and reservation rates.

Single-Year Reserved Seating

Our second seating option is a single-year reserved seat. Like the permanent seats, these seats are located in the main sanctuary and Section E. They are reserved during all Rosh Hashanah services, Kol Nidre and Yom Kippur services with the exception of the afternoon and evening Yom Kippur services which offer open seating. Unlike permanent seats, these seats are available for purchase one High Holiday season at a time. The seating reservation period begins at a designated time in the Spring and is offered on a first come first served basis. After the High Holiday season, purchasers of these seats have the right of first refusal to purchase the seats permanently. Please see the seating chart and reservation rates.

*After the High Holiday season for which the seats were purchased, those who reserved single-year seats will have the right of first refusal to purchase those seats permanently. This right will be valid until May 1st of the following year. The single-year reservation fee will be applied to the final purchase price.
